

Out of courtesy to everyone in attendance, we ask that you wear a mask and practice social distancing. Please do not enter the competition if you have the following COVID symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

Odyssey Dance's procedure will be as follows:

- 1. Dressing Rooms: Odyssey Dance will provide each studio with their own space in the dressing room. It will be up to the studio to determine the social distancing within each studio while in the dressing room area. For any dancer uncomfortable changing in the dressing room, there will be bathrooms both backstage and all throughout the venue.
- 2. Sanitizing: Odyssey Dance will provide multiple hand sanitizing stations at the following locations the entrance, merchandise/registration, backstage, and dressing rooms. We will wipe down all awards and constantly Lysol backstage. We have cleaned and disinfected our flooring thoroughly, and will do so before and at the end of the event each day.
- 3. Audience Seating: Odyssey Dance is working with the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum to provide social distancing in the seating area.
- 4. Masks: Any Odyssey Dance Staff in contact with studios/guests will be wearing a mask. Dancers are welcome to wear masks when performing if they choose. We ask that dancers wear a mask at all other times at the event.
- 5. Awards Presentations: Odyssey Dance will be doing more awards presentations to minimize the number of dancers on stage at once, as well as spectators in the venue.
- 6. Live Stream: Odyssey Dance will be live streaming the event on Facebook (Odyssey Dance Competitions / @odysseydancecompetitions) for anyone who does not feel comfortable attending the event.
